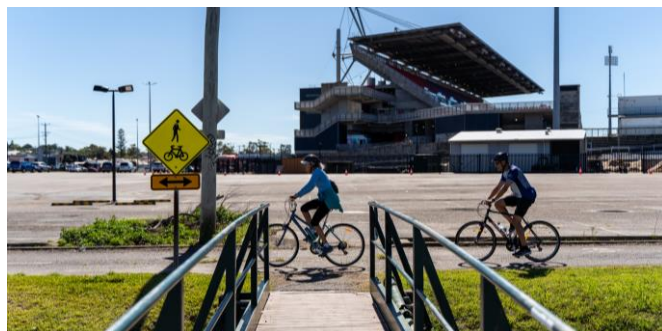
Frequently asked questions
